

The Surrey County Athletic Association was formed in November 1990, incorporating the Surrey County AAA (founded in 1920) and the Surrey County Women's AAA (founded in 1932).

It had taken some time for the sport to pick itself up after the Great War, and the inaugural men's race was not held until March 1922. It started from the Downs Hotel, Epsom, and consisted of two laps of the Downs before turning onto the Derby Course to finish.

Over the years the competition dates have fluctuated; sometimes held before the turn of the year, and sometimes after. In the results that follow, we show dates as ccyy/cc to indicate the winter season in which the race was held.

There has been a variation in the way team places have been calculated. Race positions without brackets are actual individual placings in the race, followed by scoring places in brackets (where non-scorers, and sometimes runners from incomplete teams, have been removed before any team results were calculated).

no scoring places are shown, unless noted otherwise, the race positions are also the scoring positions (in other words non-scorers have not been removed before calculations).

In the early years athletes were always shown in the results only with their initials and surname. For an athlete's first appearance in the list we show their initials, name by which they were commonly referred to (if known), and surname. Subsequent occurrences show only their commonly known name and surname – unless a lack of knowledge leads us to stick to initials. From about 1945 we are almost always able to show the given or commonly known name, and surname.

Despite thorough examination of the Sources mentioned below, we are still looking for results which will allow us the recording of all runners for 1921/22, 1922/23 and 1958/59, and non-scoring runners for 1953/54.

³ 1932/33. A.F. Mitchell arrived on the course a few minutes before the start, having worked through the night and only getting two hours sleep. The team had already been declared so he had to run as an individual, but his 15th place was rewarded by Captain Bert Footer giving the late comer his own team gold medal.

⁴ 1933/34. On this day twelve more Belgravians ran in the Middlesex Championship at Northolt Aerodrome where, under the name of Cadogan AC, they won the Middlesex Championship, led home by race winner Arthur Allum. It was the first time that Cadogan AC (open only to members of Belgrave H) had been allowed to score, the championship only previously being open to teams that had a headquarters in Middlesex. In those days athletic clubs were only allowed to affiliate to one county association – hence the formation of an alternate club. A similar double team win was recorded the following year.

⁵ 1934/35. Arthur Penny completed a substantial part of the race with a fractured foot, otherwise a Belgrave clean sweep of the medals might have been achieved.

⁶ During the Second World War Belgrave Hall was one of the very few centres from which cross-country could be held during the difficult times prevailing. 'Surrey County Cross-Country Championships' were held from this venue, over Wimbledon Common, during the early war years, with only four to score in each team, and 'A' and 'B' teams allowed. The newspapers described the events as 'substitutes' for the Championship. Elsewhere the results are not included among Surrey Championship results (for example, the engraving of team winners on the 'Pickett Trophy' itself; but as the races included Belgrave runners of some repute, and at the height of their careers, and this document is produced primarily for the consumption of Belgrave readers, we have included the results here for completeness. On the same day in the Middlesex 'substitute' Championship, Cadogan AC (Belgrave Harriers' Middlesex runners) placed 2nd with 39 pts to Polytechnic Harriers' 32.

⁷ As above, but Ranelagh H. were 2nd in the 'Surrey' race with 38 points. In the Middlesex 'substitute' championship on the same day at Ruislip, Cadogan AC were 2nd to Finchley H.

⁸ For the 1945/46 race, it was decided by the Surrey County organisers that in view of the small field, only four from each team should score.
