

The 'Club Championship Meeting' appears to have grown out of the Belgrave Harriers Annual Evening Meeting, held as early as 1890 at the South London Harriers' Ground at Balham. This meeting had moved to the Putney Athletic Club Grounds by 1892 and thereafter the London Athletic Club grounds at Stamford Bridge were used up until the First World War – with a brief sojourn at the recreation grounds of the Morgan Crucible Company at Earlsfield in 1911.

Occasionally the Evening Meeting featured Club Championship events: 100 yards in 1903, a half-mile in 1904, and a quarter-mile in 1905 to 1909 and then 1914.

With the war over, sporting life was slowly resumed, and in 1919 Belgrave Harriers recommenced the Annual Evening Meeting, held now at the grounds of Price's Candle Factory in Magdalen Road, Earlsfield, when the 440 yards event was held once more.

In 1922 a 100 yards event and a 2 miles walk were also added to the programme and it was agreed to purchase a cup to be presented to the winner of the 100 yards. The meeting was held for a fourth time at Price's Athletic Club ground, where the track was marked out on the grass sports field, but in 1923 the meeting was switched to Battersea Park and it was decided to set faster standard times for the walk as "on the cinders" the competitors were expected to perform somewhat faster. A championship for 880 yards was added to the programme in 1924 and we now had the basis for what became known as the Club Championship Meeting.

Except for the 3 miles/5000 metres, 6 miles/10,000 metres, and the sprint hurdles, championship events were almost always competed for at a "main" Club Championships Meeting on a Saturday afternoon in mid to late summer. Until 1937 this meeting continued to take place at Battersea Park. In 1938 and 1939 the meeting switched to Tooting Bec and, after the Second World War, the meeting varied between these two tracks before moving to Hurlingham at the end of the 1950s/early 1960s. By 1978 the Championship Meeting had moved to Motspur Park for a while, before going back to Battersea with an occasional foray to Tooting.

Gold and silver plated, and bronze medals, were awarded to the first three in any championship, with a bronze medal available to any competitor outside the first three who achieved the Club's "standard". Such was the confidence that there would be a strong field for each event, the place medals were engraved with the position and year before the meeting.

The period from the '50s to the '70s were probably the glory days of this annual meeting. A trestle table was laid out with all the trophies on display, each of which was presented by the President or his partner. An array of track judges and timekeepers were on duty, together with several teams of field events officials. Those who were no longer in a state of fitness enabling them to compete, or perhaps whose ambitions lay with the long distances on the road, were pressed into service as stewards, and there were often enough competitors to warrant heats and a final in the sprints.

Ironically, as the Club's strength grew, the Championship Meeting became less well supported, particularly by the Club's higher-level competitors. With medals sometimes being picked up "cheaply" through a lack of "quality competitors", a rule was introduced to prevent second and third place medals being awarded unless the Club's "standard" had been attained in achieving the place; and to avoid wastage of medals they were no longer engraved beforehand.

The early 1990s saw the championships held over four mid-week evenings, which did improve the numbers temporarily, but of course it denied those living or working further away from London the chance to take part.

In 1994 the meeting reverted to a full Saturday afternoon at Battersea Park, but by now, with five age groups and both genders to cater for, and league matches to take part in on most other Saturdays, the spread of competitors was pretty thin. In many cases the championship competitions were run as mixed gender and age group events, and results for the different categories were compiled afterwards. Sometimes Under-20s and Under-17s were listed in the Senior results, even though there were separate age-group categories.

Junior, or Under-20, Men's championship events disappeared from the programme from around 1985 with those younger members encouraged to compete for the Senior championships.

Additionally, throughout the 1990s, Under-17 championships seem to have come and gone. The view has been taken that if races were run with all age groups together, and an Under-17 championship result was separately published, Under-17s are not usually shown in the Senior result. Footnotes have been added where necessary to explain the situation and age group status has been added after the athletes' names where they have been included in an older category.

With fewer athletes taking part, the difficulty of finding a Club Championship date among all the weekends allocated for the leagues, and with officials being called upon virtually every Saturday and Sunday during the summer, 1997 saw the last "main" Club Championships Meeting, although the competitions for the 5,000 metres and 10,000 metres, traditionally held mid-week, struggled on for another decade.

## The “G. Thomas Challenge Cup” for 440 yards & the “J.G. Sawyer Memorial Cup” for the 440 yards / 400 metres

When the championships were resumed after the First World War, a rather sad faced man could be seen at all our Battersea Park track meetings, firmly grasping the rails which separated the public footpath from the finishing straight of the track, intent upon every stride of every race. His name was Joe Sawyer, and perhaps his thoughts, as he watched, were for two sons who had been killed in the Great War 1914-1918. Various members of the Sawyer family had been Belgravians, including four of Joe’s sons, and apart from competition they were involved in everything from Committee work to marking out the ground for races and field events.

The “G. Thomas Challenge Cup” awarded to the Club Champion had been won outright in 1920, so in 1921 “The J.G. Sawyer Memorial Cup” was presented by the Sawyer family to be competed for in the 440 yards Championship, in perpetuity, but to be returned to the club should it ever disband. J.G. Sawyer had won the silver medal in 1914. Sadly, when club championships went out of fashion in the 1990s, that cup was rather unsympathetically “re-engraved,” although leaving the old detail visible, and presented for an open 10k race around Wimbledon Common. A further cup, “The A.J. Sawyer Memorial Cup” was similarly presented by the Sawyer family in 1921, to be competed for in the 2 miles Walking Championship.

<sup>2</sup> The programme for the Championships in 1920, recorded that the “G. Thomas Challenge Cup” would become the property of the holder after three wins; it further noted that F.W. Rickard, the current holder already had two wins to his name. We know that the 1920 race was won by R.B. Seaman, but he resigned from the Club soon afterwards, returning the cup. Fred Rickard was then promoted to become Club Champion and as the holder of the “G. Thomas Challenge Cup” for the third year, it became his own property.

## The “Griffen Cup” for the 3 miles / 5,000 metres

Bill Griffen was the licensee of The Rising Sun in Ebury Bridge Road, the Club's mid-week quarters from the early 1920s to the late 1930s. Bill was an ardent follower of Belgrave's fortunes and presented this trophy in 1928.

The race was traditionally held as the main event in an evening meeting at Battersea which included a couple of handicap races and field events. Until the 1990s it was always very popular, sometimes seeing a couple of dozen runners, but championship races seemed to lose their attraction around this time. No results were published for 1998 to 2000 and as the main club championship meeting had been abandoned from 1998 it seems that this championship also first slipped into abeyance at that time. In 2001 the race was resurrected, held in conjunction with an open race as part of the Belgrave Speed Grand Prix Meetings. With the demise of the Grand Prix events in 2007 the “Griffen Cup” was awarded to the Belgravian recording the fastest 5,000m of the year, but this practice did not continue, and despite the best efforts to keep the event going, the trophy was no longer awarded after that year.

## The “Tom Carter Trophy” for the 6 miles / 10,000 metres

Belgrave stalwart Tom Carter presented this trophy, instigating the Club’s longest track running championship. As for the 3 miles event, the six miles championship was originally held as the main race during an evening meeting at Battersea.

By the 1990s a smaller number of competitors (and officials) resulted in a joint race being promoted by Belgrave Harriers and Veterans’ A.C. From 1998 until 2004 (except for 2003) the 10,000m race was incorporated into the Surrey County Championship, held during the Herne Hill Harriers Open Meeting at Tooting. In 2003 the race was held as an open event within one of the Belgrave Speed Grand Prix Meetings at Battersea but with fewer and fewer Belgrave competitors taking part, it was decided in 2007 that the trophy should be awarded to the Belgrave member recording the fastest 10,000m of the year. The latter practice did not continue when no Belgravian ran a 10,000m track race anywhere in 2008.
