

The Championship Race

Originally known as the South of the Thames Second Class Inter Club Race, for those teams that were not considered worthy of competing against the major clubs, the first race was held from The Freemason's Hotel, Battersea Rise, Wandsworth Common in 1888. In those days the field wended its way to Balham high road, up Bedford Hill, across Tooting Bec Common, down Back-lane to Tooting Junction Station, across Figg's Marsh, taking to the plough, back to Tooting Bec Common, to Trinity-road, through Spencer Park and home.

Belgrave Harriers did not take part until 1900, but might have done so in 1890, but for a group of the Club's runners leaving to join Battersea Harriers, a club which had a better a chance of doing well – and in fact won that second edition of the race.

Originally only twelve runners were allowed to be entered, the first six of whom formed the scoring team. The 'Sir Jeremiah Colman Cup' competition was added in 1926 for the club that managed to get all its twelve men home with the lowest score. This feat became somewhat easier in later years when the restriction of only twelve entries per team was lifted.

Barring clauses ruled out a considerable number of top class runners, one of those clauses being that any member of a winning team was ruled out of the race for the next three years. This made it very difficult to turn out a competitive team following a victory and makes the sequences of 1st-2nd (1929-1930), 1st-2nd-1st-1st (1946-1949) and 1st-1st-1st (1998-2000) all the more remarkable. All barring clauses were removed from 2004.

Gaps remain in our knowledge of all of the Belgrave runners who have competed in the event, but we are nearly always able to show the first six – the scorers in the championship. More detail will be added as we track it down.

Venues before Belgrave's participation: 1888 – Wandsworth Common, 1889 – Race not held, 1890 to 1894 – Wandsworth Common, 1895 to 1896 – Norbury, 1897 to 1899 – Bromley Common.
