

The English National 6-Stage Road Relay Championship for Women was inaugurated in 2000 and for the first fifteen years was held over equal length (or what we would now call 'short') stages. A couple of long stages were added from 2015, giving the event more of the flavour of the men's race. The length of the stages has varied over the years, thus annoying statisticians who like to compare the runners of today with those of earlier eras. From the very first race until today, entry has been open to all clubs, without them first having to rely on negotiating an area qualifying race.

Belgrave's debut was in the third edition of the race, in 2002, where on the initial stage Birhan Dagne led the charge up the hill to the take-over – the only time, so far, that Belgrave have hit the front. The team ended up 5th that day. It's been a mixed bag of results since then, but claret & gold vests have featured in the top ten team places no less than nine times, with the best, 4th, coming in 2024, where the Club had complete 'B' and 'C' teams to back up, and 4th again in the latest edition of the race; not a bad record at all. Medals are surely not far away.

Figures in brackets () after each team member's name indicate the team's position after that athlete's run. A following number, if present, represents the runner's ranking among top ten fastest times on that stage. If a third number is present, then that indicates the athlete's ranking among top 30 times for the entire race. I.e. (7, 6, 16) = team lying 7th, 6th fastest on the stage, 16th fastest for the day.
