Senior Women

It was getting on for a decade after the formation of Belgrave's female section that runners in ones, twos and threes began to transfer some of the burgeoning track and field interest to the open fields and countryside. Just occasionally a full team was turned out, but eventually the threes became fours – or more – and, mirroring the 'National' performances, it is now a regular occurrence to see half a dozen or more tackle the 'Southern'. With the increased participation has come some high-class performances. Four times the team has placed among the top three, with Tish Jones claiming an individual medal.
