

The Surrey County Athletic Association was formed in November 1990, incorporating the Surrey County AAA (founded in 1920) and the Surrey County Women's AAA (founded in 1932).

This publication covers the period from the first race in the 1921/22 season up to 1969/70. Individual statistics also only cover that period researched. Checking of detail is still being undertaken.

In the statistics, after the results for each age group, the year indicates the second year of the winter season, i.e., 22 = 1921/22. The stats are obviously affected by the fact that there are unknown runners, particularly in the earlier years. Positions shown for individuals are actual placings in the race, where known, followed by scoring places in brackets, where known.

² 1925/26. H.E. Footer does not feature in the result recorded on the Surrey Athletics website, where position 8 is shown as being occupied by J. Hoyle (Epsom H). Newspaper reports do show Footer 8th, however, and the team scores back this up.

³ 1932/33. A.F. Mitchell arrived on the course a few minutes before the start, having worked through the night and only getting two hours sleep. The team had already been declared so he had to run as an individual, but his 15th place was rewarded by Captain Bert Footer giving the late comer his own team gold medal.

⁴ 1933/34. On this day twelve more Belgravians ran in the Middlesex Championship at Northolt Aerodrome where, under the name of Cadogan AC, they won the Middlesex Championship, led home by race winner Arthur Allum. It was the first time that Cadogan AC (open only to members of Belgrave H) had been allowed to score, the championship only previously open to teams that had a headquarters in Middlesex. In those days athletic clubs were only allowed to affiliate to one county association – hence the formation of an alternate club. A similar double team win was recorded the following year.

⁵ 1934/35. Arthur Penny completed a substantial part of the race with a fractured foot, otherwise a Belgrave clean sweep of the medals might have been achieved.

⁶ This race was run during wartime from Belgrave Hall, which had become one of the very few centres from which cross-country was held during difficult times. The race was run with only four to score and 'A' and 'B' teams ran. It was described in the newspapers as a 'substitute' for the Championship. so is not included in the following statistics.

⁷ For the 1945/46 race, it was decided by the Surrey County organisers that in view of the small field, only four from each team should score.
